There are 10 cattle, numbered 0-9, in an open arena. A foul line, made out of lime or flour, is usually poured across the width of the arena, so judges and riders can know exactly where the foul line is located. The announcer will call a number, and the team must bring that numbered cow, then the next 2 consecutively numbered cattle across the line, again, in order, and put them in the pen at the other end of the arena. If a cow crosses the line out of order, it is a no time. If any of the cows sorted, go back to the herd and cross the line, it is a no time. If any other cows cross the line, it is a no time.

The classes will be the same as a regular MOTPA, as will the entry fees. Because this is the first show of the new season for this promoter, it will be a DOUBLE POINTS SHOW!

So, if you are craving Open Arena fun, come to New Bloomfield (conveniently located near the center of the state, just South of Kingdom City, off I-70) at Sunset Ranch and Barn on Dec. 14th.
